## YOU NEED TO KNOW!

Before you ride, familiarize yourself with the basic laws of the State hosting the event you plan to attend. What is allowed in your home state may be considered illegal in others.

The most commonly issued citations and criminal charges involve the following infractions:

- Mandatory Helmet Laws
- Excessive Bike Noise or Illegal Exhaust Pipes
- Illegal Handle Bars or Frame
- Illegal Aftermarket Parts
- Minimum Required Insurance
- DUI/DWI Intoxication Levels

Don't allow yourself to become a victim of not being informed. Being from out of state will not excuse you from following the law. Also remember that the smallest traffic infraction can be a reason for the police to pull you over. This gives them the perfect opportunity to get a good look at you and your bike, which can often lead to much more serious criminal charges. If, despite your best efforts, you are arrested or are involved in an accident, free legal advice is only a phone call away.
